



On the lower left hand side click on SLOs






Under SLO assessment ongoing, click on PROGRAM

- Make sure all the major courses for your program and the program SLOs are listed and match what has been published in the EVC catalog / curricunet program of record.
- Map each Program SLO to at least one ILO
- Make sure every required course for your Program is listed under "Program courses"
- Make sure each course is mapped to I,D, or M if appropriate. (the key listed below is found at the bottom of the PLO matrix:

Program Level SLOs are Student Learning Outcomes for a program that will be assessed to measure the effectiveness of that course of study (program is defined as course of study leading to a degree or certificate)
Write the Program Major Courses in the third section and mark the grid as follows: (note: there may be a course that does not address the SLO assessed. In this case, no "I, D or M" will be listed beneath the course)

I = the SLO is introduced in this course

D = the SLO is developed and practiced with feedback in this course

M = the SLO is mastered and measured in this course

Analysis/Action Plan: Once you collect and analyze assessment data, state what modifications will be made to improve the SLO outcomes and when. Once completed, provide electronic copy to Division Office and EVC SLO Coordinator

- Make sure to complete the analysis/action plan and timeline for each course listed under Program courses.
 - This is easily accomplished by simply referring to the SLO matrix for each course listed under Program courses.
 - In the above example one could need to review the SLO matrix for general psychology; Math 063, and Introduction to Research Methodology. This is where faculty would find assessment results.
 - Faculty simply review the results for each course, for example in the above screen shot MA 63 does not assess PLO #1, but the two psychology courses do. By reviewing assessment results in those courses as they relate to PLO #1; the results are summarized in the Analysis column.
 - After completing this work, faculty would then move on to PLO #2 and repeat the process.
