

## TUBERCULIN SKIN TEST (TB TEST) for F-I Students

All International Students are **REQUIRED** to have a Tuberculosis Skin Test. The test result **MUST BE NEGATIVE**. If the result is positive, student must obtain a Chest X-Ray. A standard medial report from an official hospital with English translation is sufficient. In the case a test result is not available in English, students are required to use this form and have it signed by a physician in your home country.

Note: The TB Test is to confirm an applicant is free of contagious tuberculosis. In the case an applicant has contagious disease, s/he may be required to leave the U.S.

**Results of a TB Skin Test should be dated WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF APPLICATION DATE.**
