Dear K-12 Partner,

As a result of the California budget crisis, Evergreen Valley College and San Jose City College is reducing course offerings for summer 2012. This has resulted in both colleges finding it necessary to postpone enrollment for high school freshman, sophomore, and middle school students. While we remain committed to our service area schools, the need to maintain priority registration among our high school student population has become increasingly evident. Therefore, both colleges will continue to give priority to high school seniors and juniors. While our decision to limit enrollment has been a difficult choice, it is necessary.

Students will be limited to one course because of the reductions in services at the college. By establishing a priority system, the goal is to increase the number of opportunities for students to enroll in a summer school course.

High school students must submit their application for admission and concurrent enrollment (R-40) form by **April 30, 2012**. Early submission enables students to take full advantage of their priority registration date scheduled for **May 14, 2012**.
