I like to distinguish between a "goal mindset" and a "growth mindset." A leader with a "goal mindset" has very tangible, numerical goals to achieve over a specific period of time. Nothing is wrong with clearly defined goals, but there's a better way of thinking that I call a "growth mindset." A growth mindset recognizes goals on the journey, but only as part of a process—not as the end results.

Successful Leaders are tempted to stop working on themselves, but when the he doesn't grow, his team doesn't grow. It's the Law of the Lid: a stagnant leader stunts the growth of the team. I hope these thoughts on leadership will inspire you to maintain this "growth mindset," for your personal benefit and for the benefit of those you lead.
