TEACHING MODALITIES

Distance Education (DE)


- 1. Fully Asynchronous: 100% online, no meetings
- 2. Asynchronous Hybrid: partially on campus
- 3. Fully Synchronous: 100% Zoom meetings
- 4. Synchronous Hybrid: partially on campus and partially on zoom
- 5. Online Blend: partially asynchronous and

partially synchronous

Traditional Brick and Mortar

Instructor and students meet in person, on campus 100% of the time.





DE MODALITIES

Reimagining the ways we teach







FULLY ASYNCHRONOUS MODALITY FULLY ONLINE

- No required in-person, on campus or Zoom meetings
- All course content is delivered and interactions happen through the LMS (Canvas)
- Regular and substantive weekly interaction between instructor and students and among student must take place.
- An Online Orientation must be provided by first week of semester.

For the student who cannot come to campus nor attend scheduled weekly class meetings

ASYNCHRONOUS HYBRID MODALITY PARTIALLY ONLINE, PARTIALLY ONCAMPUS

- Some scheduled in-person, on campus class meetings.
- A portion of the course content is delivered through the LMS
- Allows for on-campus proctored exams
 - An Orientation must be provided by first week of semester.



For the student who can attend class meetings on campus occasionally or only one day a week

FULLY SYNCHRONOUS MODALITY Scheduled meetings via zoom

- All scheduled class meetings via Web conferencing tool (Zoom)
- LMS is used to augment course content delivery
- No required in-person, on campus meetings
- An Online Orientation must be provided by first week of semester.

For the student who cannot come to campus but can attend scheduled weekly online class meetings



SYNCHRONOUS HYBRID MODALITY PARTIALLY VIA ZOOM AND PARTIALLY ONCAMPUS

For the student who would like to attend a mixture of online and on campus meetings

- Some scheduled in-person, on campus class meetings.
- Some scheduled class meetings via Zoom
- An Orientation must be provided by first week of semester.
- Allows for on-campus proctored exams




PARTIALLY ASYNCHRONOUS, PARTIALLY SYNCHRONOUS

- Some scheduled class meetings via Zoom
- A portion of the course content is delivered asynchronously through the LMS.
- *
 - No required in-person, on campus meetings
 - An Online Orientation must be provided by first week of semester.



For the student who cannot come to campus and can only attend scheduled online class one day a week


