FINGERPRINTING (LIVESCAN) PROCESS

All Nurse Assistant/Home Health Aide students are required to complete a background check upon enrollment in order to be cleared by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) for training. Students are asked to bring any expungement papers (or paperwork showing that expungement is in process) to orientation.

The required forms for the process will be completed on the day of fingerprinting, which will take place on campus.

There is no charge to the student to complete this requirement.

The CDPH will review prior convictions on a case-by-case basis; per SB 1384 (Chapter 847), CDPH will not automatically deny a nurse assistant training application and the state certification examination process as a result of certain violations, but it is advised that any nurse assistant student who has a criminal record contact the CDPH for any denial of certification.
