NetTutor Services

EVC uses a service called NetTutor. All NetTutor tutors hold a four-year degree from an accredited college or university in the United States and have had substantial tutor training. Many of NetTutor's tutors hold advanced degrees.

NetTutor Subject Areas

NetTutor provides support for many subjects including Accounting, Administration of Justice, Anthropology, Astronomy, Biology, Business, Chemistry, Child Development, Computer Science, Economics, English, Finance, French, Geology, Health and Nursing, History, Math (Algebra, Basic Math, PreCalculus, Calculus, Statistics), Philosophy, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish including math, science, computer science, English, foreign languages, humanities, social sciences, and allied health fields. NetTutor is flexible. Students can log in to ask a simple question or sign-up for longer one-on-one tutoring sessions.

Register for NetTutor

EVC offers NetTutor to its current students free of charge. Students are able to access NetTutor directly through [Canvas](#). If students cannot access Canvas, they must register to use the service. After emailing, you will receive an email within 24 to 48 hours that explains how to set up your NetTutor account.
