Enrollment and Verification to the VA monthly

Beginning Dec. 17, 2021: The Department of Veterans Affairs will require all Post 9/11 GI Bill® recipients to verify their enrollment every month.

Visit the <u>VA Verification of Enrollment</u> web page for information about what the new requirement means for you. Options will include Opt-in for text verification or call 1-888-442-4551 to verify.

Requirements for In-State Tuition

Student eligible for GI Bill Educational Benefits below are exempt from paying nonresident tuition regardless of when the veteran separated from the military:

- Montgomery GI Bill: Active Duty Program (Chapter 30)

- Veterans Readiness and Employment Program (Chapter 31)

- Post-9/11 GI Bill Program (Chapter 33)

If you completed your active duty outside of California, please complete the <u>AB13 VACA</u> <u>Affidavit</u> and a copy of your DD214 and email to <u>evcvet@evc.edu</u>





Prohibition of Automatic Enrollment Certification

Students are required to submit the <u>Class Certification Form (CCF)</u> along with an updated Educational Plan (approved and signed by the VFC Counselor) after registration starts in order for their classes to be verified by the VA Certifying Official. Send your documents to <u>evcvet@evc.edu</u>.

Classes will not be automatically certified without the required documents.

Absence Due to Military Service

Students who are members of an active or reserve U.S. military service who receive orders compelling a withdrawal from courses are eligible to receive a "Military Withdrawal" symbol on their academic records.

Once orders are verified, "MW" may be assigned unless academic credit has been awarded. The "MW" shall not be counted in progress prohibition, dismissal procedures, and disqualification calculations.

If you receive orders, please contact the Veterans Freedom Center. Complete the <u>General Petition</u> along with a copy of your orders.
