What is the President's Volunteer Service Award?

The President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA) is an initiative of the Corporation for National and Community Service and is administered by Points of Light Institute. The award recognizes the valuable contributions Americans of all ages are making within their communities through service and civic engagement.

Who is eligible at EVC?

Evergreen Valley College students and employees who are Citizens and/or permanent residents of the United States, and have completed the required number of Service-Learning or Public Service hours over a 12-month time period.
