WHAT IS LAEP?

The Learning Aligned Employment Program (LAEP) places eligible underrepresented students in jobs and internships that relate to the student's area of study and helps defray educational costs.

WHAT'S THE BENEFIT?

Career-related jobs and internships can help you develop and refine your skills, explore future career paths and ease your transition into the work world.



GET PAID WHILE YOU LEARN

LAEP is helping to cover the costs! Supplemented funds provide wages for students when placed with companies or educational entities. Here's what's covered:

- Up to 50% is covered for positions at for-profit businesses
- Up to 90% covered for positions at public educational institutions or non-profit corporations



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Underrepresented student *
- Eligible to work in the United States
- California resident
- Meet financial aid Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements
- Demonstrate financial need
- Be in good academic standing with your school and major
- Enrolled at least half-time in Community College
