Requirements for In-State

Student eligible for GI Bill® Educational Benefits below are exempt from paying nonresident tuition regardless of when the veteran separated from the military:

-Montgomery GI Bill®: Active Duty Program (Chapter 30) -Veterans Readiness and Employment Program (Chapter 31) -Post-9/11 GI Bill® Program (Chapter 33)

Prohibition of Automatic 11 **Enrollment** Certification

Students are required to meet with the Veterans Counselor every semester, register for courses planned only by the Veterans counselor, and submit the Class Certification Form (CCF) after registration starts in order for their classes to be verified by the VA Certifying Official. Send your documents to evcvet@evc.edu.

Classes will not be automatically certified without the required documents.

Absence Due to Military Service

Students who are members of an active or reserve U.S. military service who receive orders compelling a withdrawal from courses are eligible to receive a "Military Withdrawal" symbol on their academic records.

Once orders are verified, "MW" may be assigned unless academic credit has been awarded. The "MW" shall not be counted in progress prohibition, dismissal procedures, and disgualification calculations.

If you receive orders, please contact the Veterans Freedom Center. Complete the <u>General Petition</u> along with a copy of your orders.
