As the *Mercury News* wrote in 1975, a "rural" college opened in East San José on September 3, 1975. A \$10 monthly VTA pass on Route 71 took students to the new campus. Gas was \$0.57 per gallon and the population of San José was 486,000.

On the first day, 2,500 day students took classes in the clusters of Roble and Acacia. In fact, San Felipe Road was a two-lane country road featuring cars backed up to Aborn Road as students waited to enter the 101st California Community College.

Much like today, the two anchor programs were Automotive, which started in the mid-1950s at San José City College and nursing, which started in 1960 and had its first pinning ceremony in 1962.

In 1967, the District paid \$1.35M for 155 acres, which was next to the Cortese Family Farm. The original College, at an initial cost of \$50 million, was to be built over a decade, and took UC Santa Cruz's cluster concept as its example. The clusters were a combination of classrooms, labs and vocational shops organized by major. Due to Prop 13, those plans changed. Thanks to generous bonds and community support in the late 1990s and again in the 2000s, the center of campus grew and moved towards San Felipe Road into the footprint that it is today.

At EVC's first graduation in June 1976, President Gerald Strelitz gave out 136 degrees. The commencement this past May featured 1,106 degrees and another 778 certificates.
