- I. **Call to Order:** 2:40 p.m. by Laura Garcia
- II. **Approval of Agenda:** The agenda was unanimously approved.
- III. **Approval of the Minutes:** The minutes from the March 26th meeting were unanimously approved.

**Course: BIS 135: Human Relations in the Workplace - All DE Modalities Only
(3 units)**

This course focuses on essential socio-emotional skills that employers expect, such as time management, positive attitude, critical thinking, and communication.

Action: The course was represented by Mark Smith. The ACCC recommended that this DE Only course proposal be returned to the faculty due to the course being almost out of compliance with the curriculum revision policy for CTE courses. The course was last revised 04/24/24. The faculty requested that this course proposal be deleted from the curriculum review workflow so that he can start on the Modify course proposal. It was deleted from the curriculum review workflow during the meeting by the curriculum coordinator.

Course: DLIT 502: Basic Computers and Devices + All DE Modalities (0 unit)

This course provides students with comprehensive knowledge of computer hardware components and the skills to effectively work with diverse operating systems, including traditional computers and Chromebooks.

Action: The course was represented by Nasreen Rahim. After minor edits, it was unanimously approved. **Effective spring 2027**

Course: EDIT 023: Creating Accessible Course Content + All DE Modalities (3 units)

This course provides a comprehensive exploration of accessibility and inclusive design in online learning environments, integrating contemporary AI-assisted tools and Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles.

The course was represented by Nasreen Rahim. After minor edits, it was unanimously approved. **Effective spring 2027**

Course: EDIT 026: Women in STEM + All DE Modalities (3 units)

This course will critically examine gender equity in STEM fields through the lens of intersectionality, exploring how AI and emerging technologies both perpetuate and help combat social, economic, and political barriers.

Action: The course was represented by Nasreen Rahim. After minor edits, it was unanimously approved. **Effective spring 2027**

Course: EDIT 027: Adopting and Integrating Open Education Resources (OER) + All DE Modalities (3 units)

This course prepares participants to effectively discover, evaluate, adapt, and integrate Open Education Resources (OER) using current technologies and AI-powered tools.

The course was represented by Nasreen Rahim. It was unanimously approved. **Effective spring 2027**

Course: ACCTG 001A: Principles of Financial Accounting + All DE Modalities (4 units)

This is the study of accounting as an information system, examining why it is important and how it is used by investors, creditors, and others to make decisions.

Action: The course was represented by Melody Barta. After minor edits, it was unanimously approved. **Effective fall 2027**

Course: ACCTG 001B: Managerial Accounting + All DE Modalities (4 units)

This course introduces students to managerial decision-making using accounting information.

Action: The course was represented by Melody Barta. After minor edits, it was unanimously approved. **Effective fall 2027**

Course: MATH 070: Discrete Mathematics + All DE Modalities (4 units)

This course is an introduction to the discrete and combinatorial mathematics that serves as a foundation for advanced courses in mathematics and computer science.

The course was represented by Sithparran Vanniasegaram. After minor edits, it was unanimously approved. **Effective fall 2027**

Course: MATH 072L: Support for Calculus II with Analytic Geometry (1 unit)

This course covers the underlying algebra, precalculus, and differential calculus skills and concepts that are needed for success in MATH 072 (Calculus II with Analytic Geometry).

Action: The course was represented by Sithparran Vanniasegaram. The faculty requested that this Modify course proposal be deleted from the curriculum review workflow. It was deleted during the meeting by the curriculum coordinator.

Course: MATH 073: Multivariable Calculus + All DE Modalities (5 units)

This is the third course in calculus for students majoring in mathematics, physical science, computer science, or engineering.

The course was represented by Laimi Cong-Huyen. After a minor edit, it was unanimously approved. **Effective fall 2027**

- B. Fahmida shared with the committee how the Institutional Effectiveness Committee (IEC) plans to implement the UDL in the Program Reviews.

[Title 5, § 55001](#)

- (a) Districts shall establish curriculum committees by mutual agreement between administrators and academic senates. Curriculum committees shall be either a committee of the academic senate or a separate committee that includes faculty.
- (b) Curriculum committees shall have a documented procedure for ensuring that course outlines of record for all courses approved pursuant to section 55002 describe approaches that would accommodate and engage diverse student bodies, advance equitable student outcomes, and promote the inclusion of all students.
- (c) Curriculum committees shall have a documented procedure to guarantee accessibility for every student to ensure individuals with disabilities can equally participate in learning through course outlines of record that reflect universal design for learning strategies, which include multiple means of representation, engagement, and expression to support learner variability and diversity.
